ABOUT THE ORANGE COUNTY SCHOOL OF THE ARTS

The nationally recognized Orange County School of the Arts (OCSA) provides a creative, challenging and nurturing environment that offers bright and talented students unparalleled preparation for higher education and a profession in the arts. Established in 1987, the school currently serves nearly 2,000 students in grades 7–12 and is the only specialized arts program of its kind in the region to offer tuition-free academic and arts instruction to students from Orange, Los Angeles, Riverside, San Bernardino and San Diego counties. OCSA is ranked in the top three percent of all high schools in the State of California and among the top 50 in the nation. OCSA's total operating budget is \$21 million, of which the school's Foundation raises \$8 million annually. The school has more than 100 full-time employees, as well as more than 250 part-time artist teachers, guest artists, and master teachers. Over the past 14 years, the OCSA campus has expanded into 300,000 square feet in eight buildings spanning three city blocks in downtown Santa Ana. The school recently broke ground on a 60,000-square- foot, state-of-the-art Dance, Music and Science Center which was completed in August 2015, and has raised over \$13 million to support this capital improvement project.
